

## 1. Jesus was full of the Holy Spirit

- 1) Jesus received water baptism by John. **【Luke 3 : 21 – 22】**  
The Holy Spirit came upon Him like a dove.
- 2) Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit **【Luke 4:1】**
- 3) Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness **【Luke 4:2】**

Luke 4:1 Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, left the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, <sup>2</sup> where for forty days **he was tempted by the devil**. He ate nothing during those days, and at the end of them he was hungry.

<sup>3</sup> The devil said to him, **“If you are the Son of God, tell this stone to become bread**

<sup>6</sup> And he said to him, “I will give you all their authority and splendor; it has been given to me, and I can give it to anyone I want to. <sup>7</sup> **If you worship me, it will all be yours.”**

<sup>9</sup> The devil led him to Jerusalem and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. **“If you are the Son of God,”** he said, **“throw yourself down from here.** <sup>10</sup> For it is written: **“He will command his angels concerning you to guard you carefully; <sup>11</sup> they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.”**

**【Misusing Psalm 91】**

- 4) Jesus had victory over the Satan’s temptation by the word of God. **【Luke 4:3-13】**

4 <sup>4</sup> Jesus answered, “It is written: ‘Man shall not live on bread alone

8 <sup>8</sup> Jesus answered, “It is written: ‘Worship the Lord your God and serve him only

2. Promise of Jesus **【John 14 : 26】**

John 14:26 But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

The Holy Spirit is our helper, teacher, and reminder of the word of God

## 3. Disciples walked by the Holy Spirit

- 1) The Holy Spirit is the One who teaches us the Word and reminds us of it.
  - Peter preached boldly after he received the Holy Spirit, 3,000 people were saved. [Acts 2]
  - Peter boldly proclaimed the word before the teachers of the law. [Acts 4:19]
  - Stephen boldly proclaimed the word before the teachers of the law. [Acts 7:55]
- 2) The Holy Spirit speaks to us
  - The Holy Spirit encouraged the church and grew in numbers **【Acts 9:31】**

- The Holy Spirit spoke to the congregation when they were worshipping God. **【Acts 13】**

Acts 13:2 **While they were worshipping the Lord and fasting**, the Holy Spirit said, “Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.”

- The Holy Spirit told Peter to go to house of Cornelius. **【Acts 11:12】**

Acts 11:11 “Right then three men who had been sent to me from Caesarea stopped at the house where I was staying. <sup>12</sup> The Spirit told me to have no hesitation about going with them. These six brothers also went with me, and we entered the man’s house.

- The Holy Spirit guided the mission trip.

Acts 13:4 The two of them, sent on their way by the Holy Spirit, went down to Seleucia and sailed from there to Cyprus

Acts 16:6 Paul and his companions traveled throughout the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been kept by the Holy Spirit from preaching the word in the province of Asia.

### 3) The Holy Spirit speaks of things to come.

Acts 20:23 I only know that in every city the Holy Spirit warns me that prison and hardships are facing me.

Acts 21:11 Coming over to us, he took Paul’s belt, tied his own hands and feet with it and said, “The Holy Spirit says, ‘In this way the Jewish leaders in Jerusalem will bind the owner of this belt and will hand him over to the Gentiles.’”

### 4. Let us listen and obey the Holy Spirit.

- Persecution: Though threatened and persecuted, Peter and Stephen spoke boldly as guided by the Holy Spirit.
- Jesus, filled with the Spirit: Overcame Satan's temptation and went to preach where He was led.
- Missionary Journey: While the disciples were gathered together in prayer, Paul and Barnabas were set apart and obeyed.
- Mission to the Gentiles: Peter was led by the Holy Spirit to obey and preach to the Gentiles, whom Jews avoided associating with.
- The prophetic word: Even when Paul received the word of persecution in Jerusalem, he obeyed and went.

1. Remember that the Holy Spirit helps us, speaks to us, teaches us the Word, and guides us.
2. Keep the Holy Spirit always in your heart. When you wake up in the morning, say, “Good morning, Holy Spirit.”
3. In prayer, let us seek the Holy Spirit. Both Paul and Peter, and the church in Antioch, heard the Holy Spirit speak new things in prayer. [Missionary journeys, evangelism to the Gentiles, prophecies of persecution]
4. Let us listen to the Holy Spirit's promptings. Let us obey, not judging by the flesh. Even if it is something we have never experienced before, let us trust and follow.
5. When faced with the devil's temptation, pray through the Holy Spirit. When Adam and Eve were tempted by the devil, how did they respond to the serpent's words of temptation? How did Jesus respond?
6. In our daily prayers, let us ask the Holy Spirit for guidance throughout the day. Please also pray together for the church's mission.
